AWARD RULES

Three prizes will be awarded: first, second and third place. The prize consists of a certificate and the sum of 400 Euro, 300 Euro and 200 Euro respectively.

- The prize is awarded to young scientists who have completed their Master's degree no longer than 10 years ago.
- Candidates must be active participant at the 12. Electrochemical Impedance Analysis Conference (EIA) and should apply on their own behalf.
- Candidates should submit a 2 page extended abstract to the Award Committee Chair Dr. Norbert Wagner (Norbert.Wagner@dlr.de).
- The Award Selection Committee consists of five persons: The Chair or one of the Co-chairs of the current EIA Symposium and three members nominated by the Chair of the current Symposium.
